2. Public comments.

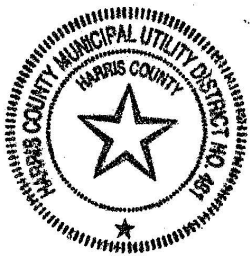
Construction Items:

 - a. authorization for design;
 - b. approval of plans and specifications and authorization for competitive bids or proposals;
 - i. water, sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Edgewater, Section PA 14 1A;
 - ii. water, sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Edgewater, Section PA 14 1B; and
 - iii. water, sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Edgewater, Water Street extension.
 - c. approval of contracts, letter financing agreements, or cost sharing agreements;
 - d. approval of pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance as appropriate, for projects in the service area;
 - e. deeds and easements;
 - f. utility conveyances to City of Webster; and
 - g. maintenance of drainage channels.
4. Landscape architect's report, including:
 - a. authorization for design;
 - b. approval of plans and specifications and authorization for competitive bids or proposals;
 - c. approval of contracts, letter financing agreements, cost sharing agreements, and easements;
 - d. Approval of pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance for projects in the service area, including:
 - i. Edgewater, Sections 5, 6, and 12 landscape improvements.


